COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

TOURO UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL AND FAYETTEVILLE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This agreement is entered into between Touro University International, or hereinafter TUI, located at 5665 Plaza Drive, 3rd Floor, Cypress, CA 90630, a branch campus of Touro College (NY), accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Senior Colleges and Universities of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, and Fayetteville Technical Community College, or hereinafter FTCC, located at 2201 Hull Road, Fayetteville, NC 28303-0236, accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

INTRODUCTION

TUI and FTCC recognize the desirability of FTCC graduates to be able to transfer from FTCC upon award of the Associate's degree to the appropriate Bachelor's degree program at TUI.

Specifically:

1. Students with the FTCC Associate's degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Business Education and Marketing, Criminal Justice, Criminal Justice Technology, and Hotel and Restaurant Management will be able to transfer into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Degree Completion concentration, or into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.
2. Students with the FTCC Associate's degree in Computer Programming will be able to transfer into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Degree Completion concentration or into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Information Technology Management, Degree Completion concentration. Students with the FTCC Associate's degree in Information Systems, Information Systems/Network Administration and Support, Information Systems Security, or Internet Technology will be able to transfer into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Information Technology Management Degree Completion concentration, into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Information Technology Management, or into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Degree Completion concentration, or into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

3. Students with the FTCC Associate's degree in Nursing, Health Education, Biotechnology, Dental Assisting, Dental Hygiene, Emergency Medical Science, Healthcare Management Technology, Medical Office Administration, Nuclear Medical Technology, Practical Nursing, Radiography, Respiratory Care, and Surgical Technology will be able to transfer into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Health Sciences, Professional Degree Completion concentration, or into the TUI Bachelor's degree in Health Sciences.

TERM

- This agreement shall be for a term of three years from the date of agreement. Unless terminated by either party prior to the end of the first term, the agreement shall automatically renew for an additional three year term.
- Either party may terminate this agreement with written notice to the other party. Such notice shall be given at least 90 days prior to the effective date of termination. In case of termination, students who have transferred from FTCC to TUI prior to the termination date shall be afforded all rights referred to in this agreement for a period of two years after the termination date.

TRANSFER OF CREDITS TO TUI

1. TUI will accept transfer of up to 60 equivalent semester credits from the Associate's degree awarded by FTCC into the appropriate TUI Bachelor's degree program as defined in the Introduction section of this agreement. A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) in transfer credits is required in the TUI Bachelor's degree program in Business Administration, Computer Science, and Information Technology Management and a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale) in transfer credits is required in the TUI Bachelor's degree program in Health Sciences.
2. Students must complete at least 60 semester credits at TUI.
3. FTCC students who transfer to TUI will be individually assessed and advised by TUI advisors to determine the optimum degree plan for the remaining courses needed to earn their selected Bachelor's degree.

FTCC agrees to inform its students and alumni of the terms and opportunities of this agreement. TUI and FTCC will determine appropriate methods of promotion.
