

**Fayetteville Technical Community College**  
**Admission Requirement**  
**Advanced Placement Option for LPN's**

1. Complete a Fayetteville Technical Community College Application within the past 6 months, if you are not a current student.
2. Provide official transcripts from all previous schools attended, including high school and or GED scores and all colleges/universities. Transcripts must be received from each individual high school and college/university.
3. Meet appropriate requirement for Reading, English and Math.
4. Meet appropriate requirement for Chemistry.
  - a. One unit of high school Chemistry course with a minimum grade of "C" OR
  - b. Developmental level Chemistry, CHM 081 and 082 with a minimum grade of "C" or,
  - c. College level chemistry courses CHM 135 and 136 or CHM 151 and 152 with a minimum grade of "C".
5. Meet appropriate requirement for Biology.
  - a. One unit of high school Biology course with a minimum grade of "C" or
  - b. Developmental level Biology 092 with a minimum grade of "C" or
  - c. College level Biology courses BIO 110 or BIO 111 with a minimum grade of "C".
6. Meet appropriate requirement for Algebra.
  - a. One unit of high school Algebra 1 and
  - b. Current ACCUPLACER score of 55 on the Algebra Portion or
  - c. Developmental level MAT 70 or 80 or
  - d. College level MAT 115 or higher
7. Completion of RELATED CLASSES: ACA 111, BIO 168, BIO 169, PSY 150, PSY 241, and ENG111 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 required prior to entering the program. You may be enrolled in a RELATED class during the spring semester prior to entry into the Advanced Placement LPN to A.D.N. program, which begins in the summer semester. However, if admitted to the program, the approval would be conditional upon your passing the RELATED class you are enrolled in that semester with a grade of "C" or better.
8. BIO 168 and BIO 169 must be taken within 5 years of entering the program. Your computer course (CIS 110/113) must have been taken within 7 years of entering the program.
9. Completion of TEAS V Testing (Test of Essential Academic Skills) within 3 years of entering the program. (Must be completed by Jan. 30 deadline.)
10. Have at least 3600 hours work experience as an LPN within the past 4 years (from any state). This should be submitted to Department Chair on employer letterhead.
11. Complete application for admission to the Advanced Placement Option by January 30<sup>th</sup> of the year planning to enroll in the summer semester. In addition student should notify the Department Chair of the Associate Degree Nursing Program and submit resume and documentation of employment hours from employer on letterhead. Letter should include, employer title, and contact information.

Deadlines:

- A. Jan 30 deadline for application for admission to Associate Degree Nursing Program.
- B. Verification of 3600 hours of work experience to department chair of Associate Degree Nursing Program. (Student Resume and statement on employer letterhead, with employer title, and contact information.)
- C. Information sessions held in early March.
- D. Applicants notified of admission by March 30.
- E. Health Forms completed May 1.
