“High Five” Principles



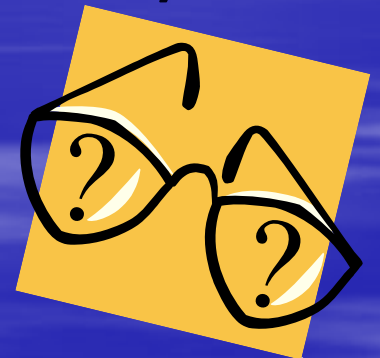
- ★ Know yourself, believe in yourself, and follow your heart.

Ask yourself these questions:

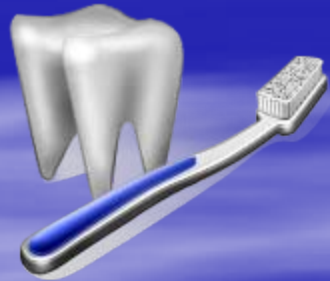
- What do you like to do?

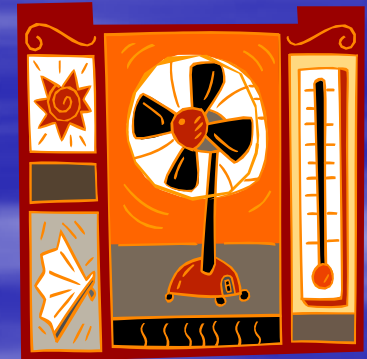

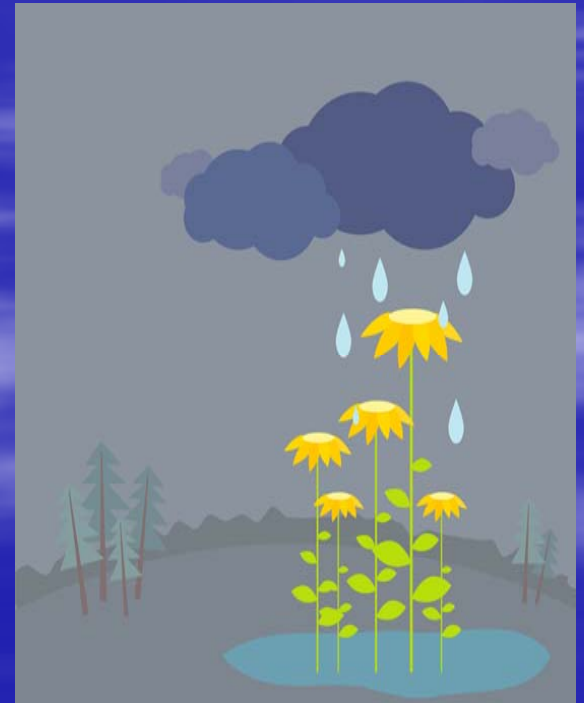
