ELECTRICIAN

Electricians help to bring about many daily comforts for most individuals. They are responsible for the heat, light, air conditioning and the power we use each day. Electricians install and maintain fuses, wiring and other components to help electricity flow. Although some electricians are self-employed individuals, many work for private companies, building contractors and governments.

The job that an electrician performs involves reading blueprints, understanding and following building codes, as well as, connecting all types of wires to circuit breakers and outlets, to name a few. This career field is very technical and it’s a “hands-on” occupation.



The educational training needed to become an electrician may vary from completing an apprenticeship and job-shadowing to completing a one to two year vocational degree. Most states require electricians to be licensed.
