

“Chat and Chew” on Careers

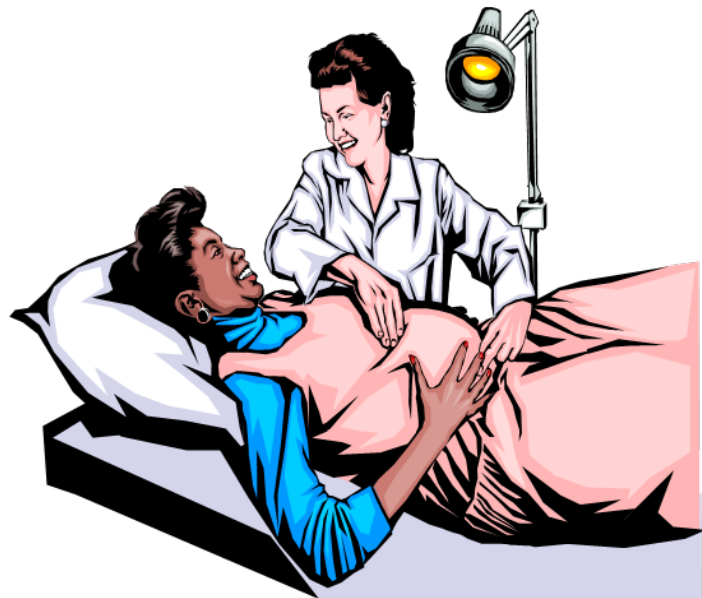
MIDWIFE

Midwives are highly trained professionals who assist women throughout their pregnancy. These individuals work in a variety of settings, to include, hospitals, clinics, medical practices, private practices and their client’s homes.

This occupation is not your typical 9-to-5 career. Often times, these individuals work 12-to-24 hour shifts. They must be ready to assist their clients with their childbirth issues at the drop of a hat.

Many midwives are registered nurses who received additional training in areas of prenatal, gynecology, newborn and postpartum care, as well as, the child bearing cycle.

Course preparation to become a midwife may take one to two years beyond attaining you RN degree. In this health occupation, women tend to dominate the market, with only about two percent of men making up the workforce.
