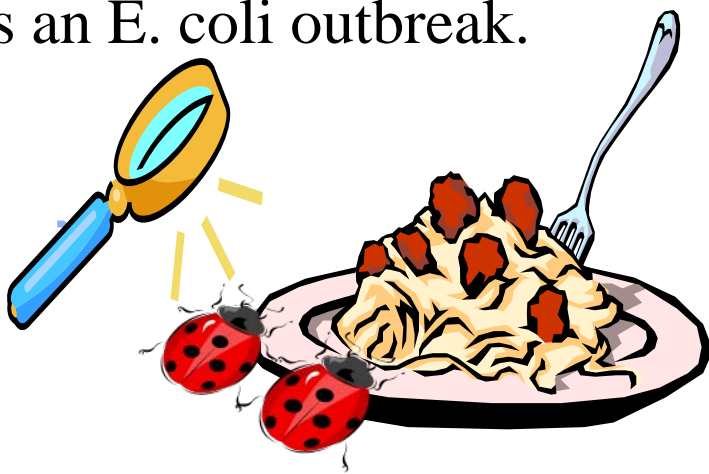


“Chat and Chew” on Careers

Food Inspector

The job of food inspectors is to track down bacteriological and chemical contamination.

They also enforce the accurate labeling of food products. Sometimes, food inspectors investigate the public concerns, such as an E. coli outbreak.
