

Bb 9.1 Course Copy: Force Browse Button to Display

On occasion the Browse button is not displayed. If you do not know the destination course ID, it may be difficult to continue the copy process. To force the Browse button to display complete the following:

- At the course copy screen select the Select Copy Type down arrow.
