POSITION VACANCY: Project Recruiter/Success Manager (NC Advanced Manufacturing Alliance) 3 Year Grant Funded Job #11-88

Fayetteville Technical Community College is seeking qualified applicants for this grant funded full-time position. The Project Recruiter works with the Project Manager and FTCC Faculty to identify job seekers and recruit potential students into the Computer Integrated Machining program, meet with groups to acquaint them with services, education, or training opportunities, and provide support/mentoring services to students enrolled in the program. Knowledge of the manufacturing industry, industrial/mechanical engineering, and/or Computer Integrated Machining is essential to this position. Qualified candidates will possess excellent communication skills, computer skills; demonstrate evidence of a career that includes flexibility and willingness to change; open-mindedness, fairness and the ability to see multiple perspectives; a willingness to take risks, and willingness to accept responsibility for professional and personal growth.

DUTIES: The successful candidate will:

- Use outreach techniques to identify job seekers and recruit potential students
- Provide information and refer individuals to public, private, or community agencies for assistance
- Build relationships between students, industry partners, and FTCC
- Work with program faculty to match students to an appropriate industry internship, monitor the internship, and provide support
- Perform other professional duties as requested by supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum Requirements: Bachelor's Degree in business, social work, education, or a related field. Work experience in a community college or job placement setting is desired. Communication, both oral and written, skills necessary. Must be able to research, organize, plan, and professionally present program activities. Extensive experience directly related to the position duties, well documented in the application packet, may be considered in lieu of the degree requirement. **Preferred:** Master's Degree in related field. Experience in managing or directing a government funded grant project.

SALARY: Grant funded, plus an excellent benefit package.

Degrees **MUST** be from a regionally accredited institution that is recognized by the Department of Education. Transcripts **MUST** show degree earned and date conferred. **Applications will not be considered without a complete packet.**
