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FTCC's Brian Haney Participates in NC Basic Economic Development Course at Chapel Hill

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – August 23, 2010 – FTCC's Brian (T.J.) Haney, Executive Director of Economic Development and Emerging Technologies, recently attended the North Carolina Basic Economic Development Course at UNC Chapel Hill's School of Government (August 2-5). The four-day course provides intensive instruction on the fundamentals of economic development practice and offers a comprehensive educational experience that integrates theoretical and practical perspectives on economic development activities and programs. The course is accredited by the International Economic Development Council and counts as one of the steps required toward the CECD certification for professional economic developers.

Haney joined FTCC May 1, 2010, as Executive Director of Economic Development and Emerging Technologies and works closely with business, industry, military, and community leaders to meet emerging training needs.
