FTCC HOSTS FREE MILITARY CONSTRUCTION TRAINING SERIES

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – March 1, 2011 - Fayetteville Technical Community College will host the North Carolina Military Business Center's open registration for Military Construction (MILCON) Pre- and Post-Award Contracting Procedures on March 8 and 10 in the auditorium at FTCC's Spring Lake campus (171 Lake Tree Boulevard, Spring Lake, NC). The training is designed to offer military construction training to businesses looking to enter the Federal Construction Market or to gain a better understanding of the Federal Construction Market. The MILCON Pre- and Post-Award two-day training classes are free; space is limited, and online pre-registration is required.

Day one of the training offers training on Quality Control and Safety Program management. The course will familiarize participants with the NAVFAC and US Army Corps of Engineers Construction Quality Management concepts and USACE Safety and Health EM 385 project requirements and procedures. General contractors, subcontractors, and vendors are encouraged to send project execution staff members for this training. Day two of the training offers participants training on "source selection," the process the government uses to select prime contractors on military construction projects. Contractors who are looking to gain a better understanding of the source selection process are encouraged to attend.

The North Carolina Military Business Center is offering this two-day series in four locations across the state, including Fayetteville, North Carolina. Participants may mix and match sessions and dates to meet their professional needs.
