FTCC Campus to Host Public Meeting with Community Leaders on Military Growth

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – September 2, 2011 – The North Carolina Military Business Center located on the campus of Fayetteville Technical Community College will host a public meeting in the multipurpose room of the Tony Rand Student Center on Wednesday, September 7, at 6 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to provide a forum for information exchange between members of the public and a panel comprised of community leaders regarding the impact of military growth on the Fort Bragg region. The information gathered will later be presented to state and federal leaders. Discussion topics will include transportation, education, infrastructure, sustainability, land use, and quality-of-life issues. Starting at 7:30 p.m., the topics will shift to a focus on military-related economic and workforce development. The event is open to the public.

“The public meeting hosted by the North Carolina Military Business Center at FTCC will be an excellent opportunity for citizens to share information with community leaders on important topics that affect the experiences of everyday life and to learn more about how our community is changing as a result of military growth in our area,” said FTCC President Dr. Larry Keen. “We invite the public to participate and have a voice in this information-exchange forum.”
