FTCC Selected for Military Friendly Schools List for 2010

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – August 18, 2009 – Fayetteville Technical Community College (FTCC) has been selected to be listed in the *2010 Guide To Military Friendly Schools*. *G.I.
