***FTCC to Host JABALI AFRIKA for Workshop and Concert February 25***

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C. – February 17, 2009 – The FTCC Student Government Association and FTCC’s Global Education Committee are sponsoring the band JABALI AFRIKA of Kenya, East Africa. JABALI AFRIKA will conduct a workshop on Wednesday, February 25, from 11-11:50 a.m. at Cumberland Hall Auditorium followed by a concert at 7 p.m. in Horace Sisk Gymnasium for FTCC students, faculty, and staff. The events are free and open to the public.

The workshop will provide an opportunity for students to learn about the political, economic, social, and tribal factors that impact the lives of Kenyans. The musical sound of JABALI AFRIKA is attributed to its unique mixture and special fusion of African rhythms. The band members are also talented dancers and choreographers, performing over 250 shows per year.
